




a Special Exhibition of Today's Infrared Photography Innovators

Infrared photography, which captures wavelengths of light outside of what is visible to human beings, was developed in 1910 by American photographer, Robert Wood. The main effect is foliage appearing white due to the amount infrared light it reflects. This can create surreal, other-worldly images. Early applications were for agriculture and the military. However, once infrared film became commercially available, photographers started using it for creative purposes. Legendary photographer, Minor White, used it to create dreamlike scenes in the 1950s. When false-color infrared film became available in the 1960s, bands like Jimi Hendrix, Frank Zappa and the Grateful Dead used it to create album covers. Cleveland photographer, Abe Franjndlich published *Cleveland Infra Red* in 1981, a portrait of the city using B&W infrared film. Today, digital cameras are able to be modified to capture infrared and ultraviolet light. As in the past, there is a small but active community of photographers working to keep infrared photography alive. GalleryPlus in the 78th Street Studios is proud to present work from some of theseinnovators. Don't miss this opportunity to see the latest trends in infrared photography from coast to coast.


